Connectors for contrast.

- Although
- Even though
- Though
- While

Are all synonymous, but take different positions in a sentence.

## Position of Although

- Although; beginning or middle.
  - Although sales have increased we are still making losses..
  - We are still making losses although sales have increased..

# Position of Even Though

- Even though; Beginning or middle.
  - Even though sales have increased we are still making losses.
  - we are still making losses even though sales have increased.

# Position of Though.

- Though; only in the middle (sometimes at the end too)
  - The company is still making losses, though sales have increased.
  - Sales have increased, the company is still making losses though.

### In Spite of / Despite

- In spite of
- Despite

Are synonymous, they can go at the start or middle of the sentence.

They are both followed by;

- Gerunds.
- Nouns.
- Clauses starting with "the fact that..."

#### Connectors for Purpose.

#### To In order to So as to

Are all synonymous and go at the start of a clause, but not necessarily at the start of the sentence.
