- I realise that you're all very busy, so I'd like to thank you for coming along today...

## Emphasising Relevance / Significance.

- Of course, you'll now see why this topic is so important to us.
- With that in mind we can see that it is crucial to change our working practice.
- Hopefully you can see why this issue is critical.
- These insights should enable you to...
- Now that you understand the key points you should be able to...
- If you're not using these techniques, you're putting yourself at a disadvantage...

#### Making a Final Statement.

- Now you know everything that you need to make your project stand out.
- Now the ball is in your court!
- Okay! Now it's time for you to put this into practice!
- So now you know the details, let's see how we can overcome this problem.
